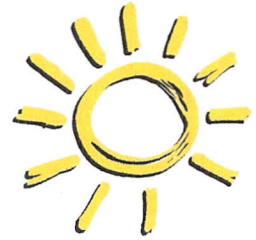

Park Rule Amendment

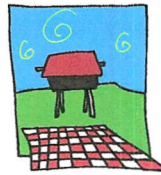
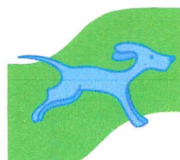

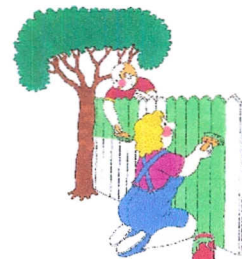

Home Site Clean-up

This Spring it is time to get all homes up to the standards of the park rules. Some things to consider for your site in addition to removing RV's, unlicensed vehicles and car covers are:

- * materials such as boxes, construction materials, car parts, old appliances or misc items cannot be stored around the perimeter of the lot, must be stored out of site or removed.
- * landscaping must be in good repair, neat and clean, sanitary and attractive
- * tow hitches should be removed or covered
- * all wooden surfaces must be painted
- * all homes should display their unit number
